1. References.


a. Interim Change No. I03, AR 40-68, subj: Quality Assurance Administration, 30 June 1995.

2. All social workers will maintain evidence of a current, valid, unrestricted license. Each medical treatment facility (MTF) Quality Assurance (QA) office will verify licensure on all social workers.

3. Please submit all licensure documentation to your MTF Credentials Coordinator in a timely manner. The QA office is responsible for entering the information into the Centralized Credentialing Quality Assurance System (CCQAS). We will not maintain a separate social work database to verify licensure. We will rely on the consolidated CCQAS database at Headquarters, U.S. Army Medical Command to audit licensure of all social workers.
