

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - RISK MANAGEMENT

QUESTION: What is the adjudication number?

ANSWER: The adjudication number is assigned by the court. It can be found within the legal document.

QUESTION: Is the CCRB tied to the Provider's Claim or the overall claims assessment?

ANSWER: It is tied to both. Once the claim is filed with the local JAG, a copy is forwarded to the MTF to get the DD Form 2526 started.

QUESTION: To forward a claim to OTSG, there are 3 choices: medical legal, MTF/MTF Committee and Other. Is the medical legal the CCRB?

ANSWER: Yes.

QUESTION: Why can't the MTFs see OTSG's rulings?

ANSWER: The MTFs can view the data in the OTSG tab, but not the Admin Tracker tab. The Admin Tracker tab is primarily a work product for the MEDCOM staff, as this information is of no value to the MTFs. The OTSG tab provides "read only" capability to the OTSG's Final Evaluation of Care, Clinical Service Code determination and Act or Omission Code determination.
